

PLEASE REVIEW THESE SAFETY AND SECURITY POLICIES BEFORE ATTENDING

We want you and your family to have a great time at our event! Please read and follow these guidelines to have a safe time. Please note that Upper Cumberland Regional Airport authorized security personnel reserve the right to remove any guest who chooses not to abide by airport safety policy.

Q. What are your COVID-19 Policies?

A. Please follow these general guidelines for public safety:

- Masks: As this is an outdoor event, masks are not required. They are strongly encouraged in any area that can become crowded such as lines for food, restrooms, rides etc.
- COVID Tests: No testing will be provided or required at the event. No proof of vaccination is required to enter
- Bring your own hand sanitizers, wipes, etc. and use them often
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing
- If you do not feel well, stay home
- Keep 6 feet of separation between you and other persons whenever possible

Q. What is not allowed to be brought into the Event?

A. In general, the following are prohibited items. Other items may be prohibited in addition to these:

- Coolers, outside food and beverage, camelbacks
- Tent structures, self-standing umbrellas
- Bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, two-wheeled scooters
- Unauthorized vehicles
- Weapons, except for those carried by authorized Law Enforcement
- Fireworks, explosives or explosive devices, and inflammables
- Alcohol or alcoholic beverages
- Controlled substances
- Destructive devices
- Pets, with the exception of service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Comfort animals are not allowed.
- All remotely controlled devices such as drones, aircraft, cars, etc.

If you arrive to the front gate with these items, you will be directed by security to return them to your car or to discard them in a trash receptacle. These restrictions are not applicable to the camping areas; however, these items may not be brought from the campground into the main exhibit area.

Q. Can I bring a backpack?

A. Due to airport security policy, any carrying bag, backpack, satchel, or similar carrying item must be presented for inspection upon entry. Purses and similar small personal items are allowed. All bags are subject to inspection. Persons unwilling to allow bag inspections will not be admitted to the event.

Q. Can I bring a cooler with snacks and drinks to the show?

A. Outside coolers and food/beverage are NOT allowed into the event. Guests will be allowed to bring up to 2 sealed bottles of water per person, no larger than 1 liter in size. If a patron has special medical dietary restrictions, items will be allowed in reasonable quantities if accompanied by a doctor's note. You will be asked to present your doctor's note to security upon entry to the event.

Q. Can I bring in my own chairs?

A. Yes.

Q. Can I bring an umbrella?

A. Personal, handheld umbrellas will be allowed into the event. Self-standing umbrellas and awning, canopies or tent structures in the event area are strictly prohibited due to safety.

Q. Are cameras and video recorders allowed?

A. Yes, feel free to take as many photos/videos as you would like and share them with us on social media.

Q. Can I bring a wagon for my kids?

A. Wagons without a concealing enclosure will be allowed.

Q. Are earplugs recommended?

A. YES! Earplugs or noise-canceling headphones can be a lifesaver if you have little ones (or anyone) with ears that need protecting – some of the aircraft can get LOUD!

Q. Can I bring a golf cart?

A. Personal golf carts are not permitted. A mobility-impaired guest may bring a personal single-seat, battery-powered cart, powered wheelchair or any ADA approved mobility device to access the show site.

Q. Are pets allowed?

A. Due to concerns for the safety of attendees and animals, no pets will be allowed onto the Event site unless they are registered service animals. For clarification on qualifications of service animals, please visit the ADA website. Never leave a pet in a hot vehicle.

Q. Is smoking/vaping allowed?

A. THERE IS NO SMOKING or VAPING ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE PREMESIS per airport policy.
